CERTIFICATE OF COVERAGE AMENDMENT

HDHP/HSA Preventive Drug List Rider 5

Federal law and the ACA require certain drugs to be covered under the Preventive Care benefit at \$0 cost-sharing under most plans. The IRS and Treasury Department have also allowed Health Plans to create a list of additional drugs used to treat certain chronic conditions that may be purchased by individuals on High Deductible Health Plans (HDHPs)/Health Savings Accounts (HSAs) outside of the plan deductible. These drugs have been found useful in preventing disease or illness and are considered preventive in this application by the IRS.

The HDHP/HSA Preventive Drug List Rider 5 benefit waives the HDHP/HSA deductible for drugs on the Piedmont HDHP/HSA Generics/Brand Preventive Therapy Drug List and allows these drugs to be purchased In-Network at a [\$00] Copayment for Tier 1 Generic drugs, a [\$00] Copayment for Tier 2 Brand drugs, a [\$00] Copayment for Tier 3 Non-Preferred Brand drugs, and [XX%] [Coinsurance] [a] [\$00] [Copayment] for Tier 4 Specialty drugs up to a 30-day supply. [Tier 4 Specialty Drugs have an out-of-pocket maximum of [\$00] per 30-day supply.]

Piedmont also allows these drugs to be purchased In-Network for a Retail 90 or Mail Order 90 supply as available (up to 90-day or 300 unit supply) for Tier 1, Tier 2, and Tier 3 drugs at a [\$00] Copayment for Tier 1 Generic drugs, a [\$00] Copayment for Tier 2 Brand drugs, and a [\$00] Copayment for Tier 3 Non-Preferred Brand drugs.

Please note:

- This drug list is updated monthly and drugs may be added or removed.
- Specialty Drugs must be purchased from the Pharmacy Benefit Manager's Specialty Pharmacy.
- The cost-sharing payment for a covered prescription insulin drug is limited to a \$50 maximum per 30-day supply, and any deductible is waived.
- The Specialty Pharmacy will fill only 30-day retail and 30-day mail order Specialty Drug prescriptions; 90-day retail and 90-day mail order prescriptions are Not Available.
